

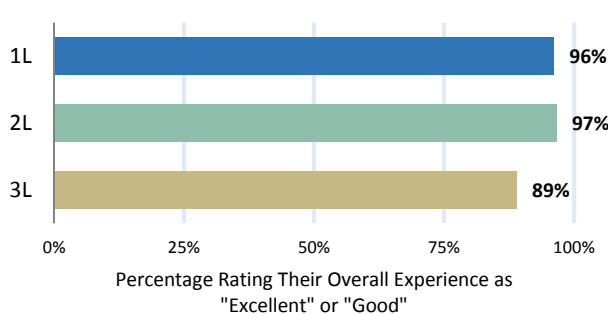
2014 Law School Survey of Student Engagement RESULTS

UCI Law students in spring 2014 participated in the Law School Survey of Student Engagement (LSSSE) along with more than 21,000 students from 70 law schools throughout the United States and Canada. The LSSSE asks students about their law school experience – how they spend their time, what they feel they've gained from their classes and their assessment of the quality of interactions with faculty and friends.

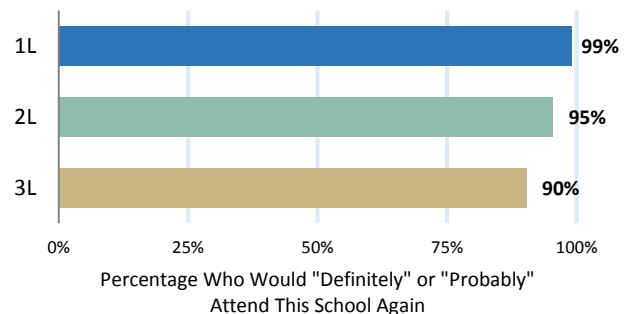
TOP OF THE CLASS

When it comes to student satisfaction, UCI Law far exceeds the overall average*:

* The 2014 LSSSE average satisfaction rating across all schools is 83%, and 80% of all 2014 LSSSE respondents say they would likely choose the same law school again. UCI Law had a very high overall LSSSE response rate – 81% of our students elected to take the survey, compared to an average of 47% of other participating schools.

THE 1L EXPERIENCE

A vast majority of the 100+ first-year UCI Law students who participated in the 2014 LSSSE say they are satisfied or very satisfied with the Law School's student advising services. Here's a snapshot of their collective responses, alongside the average 1L ratings across all participating schools:

** Percentage of students who responded "satisfied" or "very satisfied." 85% of UCI Law's 1Ls elected to take the survey; the average 1L response rate across all participating schools was 50%.
