SELECTION CRITERIA AND PROCEDURES

Each candidate must be a law student who has successfully completed at least one year of law school. Strong preference will be given to current residents of Fresno, Kern, Kings, Madera, Mariposa, Merced, Stanislaus, Tulare or Tuolumne Counties.

Primary considerations are academic achievement and the breadth and depth of the applicant's extracurricular and community activities.

Financial need and demonstrated leadership capabilities are also taken into consideration.


