ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Recipient is a member of an ethnic or racial minority or any individual who demonstrates a defined commitment to issues of diversity within their academic career.
- Recipient is a U.S. citizen currently attending an accredited law school within the United States.
- Academic achievement as reflected by a minimum 3.0 GPA and have completed at least one semester of classes at an accredited law school.

REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must submit by May 31, 2014:

- A completed Scholarship Application Form.
- One-page typed essay describing how you will utilize your law degree to promote ethnic diversity.
- A certified copy of law school transcript.

The award recipient shall provide the following documentation to obtain the scholarship:

- Proof of Legal Residency in U.S. (i.e. birth certificate, passport, permanent resident card, etc.)
- The Buckfire & Buckfire, P.C. scholarship is to be used exclusively for law school tuition and related expenses. A check for \$2,000.00 will be made payable to the award recipient's law school to cover these expenses and he or she is expected to submit receipts in accordance with IRS regulations.

AWARD

The Buckfire & Buckfire, P.C. award recipient will be notified of the selection on or about July 1, 2014.
