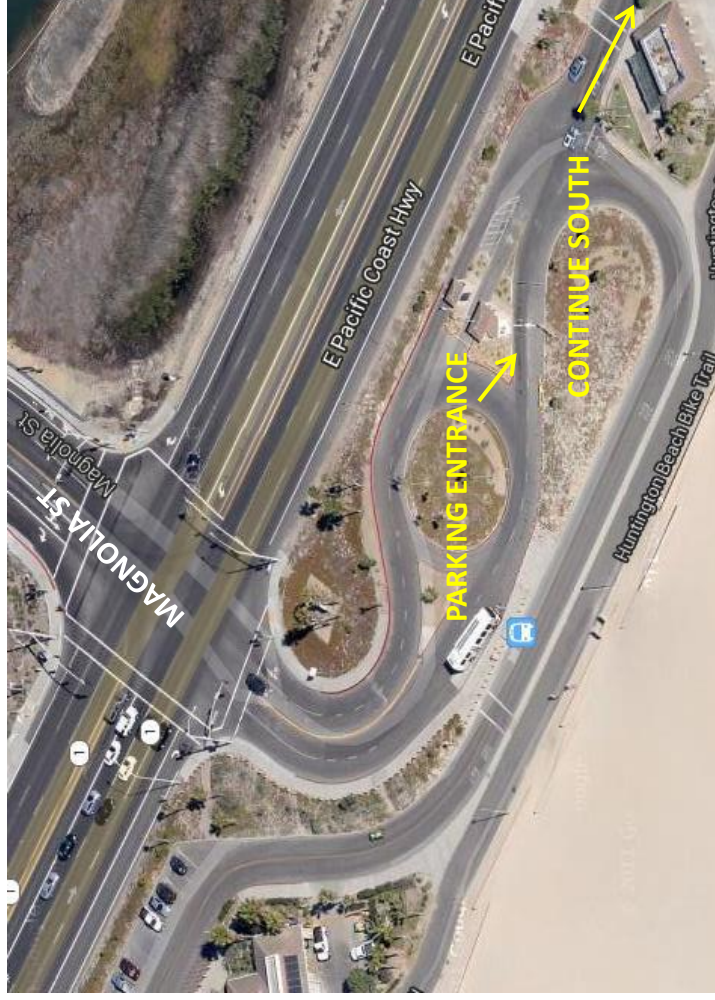

Once in the parking lot, stay left (south) until Tower #2. *Parking fees are waived for Coastkeeper Beach Clean-Up volunteers.* A map has been attached for your convenience.

Additional Information: Coastkeeper will provide trash bags and gloves for picking up litter. You may bring your own durable work gloves if you prefer. Comfortable clothing, closed-toed shoes and sunscreen are recommended. Wear your OCBA volunteer T-shirt if you have one and remember to bring a reusable water bottle.
