

UCI Law evaluates Early Decision applications using the same selection criteria as regular decision applications. However, Early Decision applicants' interest in UCI Law, evidenced by their Early Decision application designation, is specially considered by the Admissions Committee. Otherwise, they have no significant advantage in the selection process. Refer to the application and application instructions for Early Decision deadlines.

If admitted through the Early Decision program, applicants commit themselves to matriculating at UCI Law. Applicants may <u>not</u> apply to other Early Decision programs during the same admissions cycle. Early Decision applicants may only apply to other law schools on a regular decision basis. Upon admission to UCI Law through the Early Decision program, applicants must withdraw all other law school applications and may initiate no new applications. Failure to honor these commitments may result in the revocation of the Early Decision admission offer.

Applicants admitted through the Early Decision program receive a \$30,000 annual scholarship (\$90,000 cumulative over the three years of the JD program). Early Decision applicants may apply for additional financial aid in need based grants or loans. Specific information on individual financial aid awards is available **after** Early Decision applicants are notified of the decision on their application. If financial aid is a significant factor in determining where to attend law school, Early Decision applicants should carefully consider applying to UCI Law's Early Decision program because they will not be able to compare financial aid awards from other law schools.

In order to secure their spot in the Fall 2021 entering class, **all admitted** applicants will be required to submit both a positive Statement of Intent to Register and pay a monetary seat deposit no later than the date(s) indicated with their offer of admission.

Applicants not admitted through the Early Decision program will be held and evaluated again as part of the regular applicant pool.

UCI Law reserves the right to provide peer law schools with the names of applicants accepted under our Early Decision program.

## Instructions:

If you agree to the above terms of the Early Decision program and you wish to apply as an Early Decision candidate at UCI Law, then you must complete this form and submit it as part of your application materials no later than November 15. You will be notified of the Law School's decision by the end of December.

## Certification:

I certify that I have read the above and understand the stated policies and practices that govern the Early Decision admission program at UCI Law, and I wish to be considered as an Early Decision candidate. During this admissions cycle, I have not submitted and will not submit an application for Early Decision at any other law school nor will I enter into an Early Decision agreement with any other law school.
