Award Criteria

- Current enrollment in an accredited law school as a rising second or third year law student
- 2. Good academic standing
- 3. An interest in advocacy and/or public interest law
- 4. Preference will be given to candidates with a diverse background

Applicants must submit the following by May 25, 2018:

- 1. Statement of interest not to exceed 500 words
- 2. An official law school transcript (e-transcript sent directly from the school will be accepted)
- 3. Two letters of recommendation
- 4. All contact information
