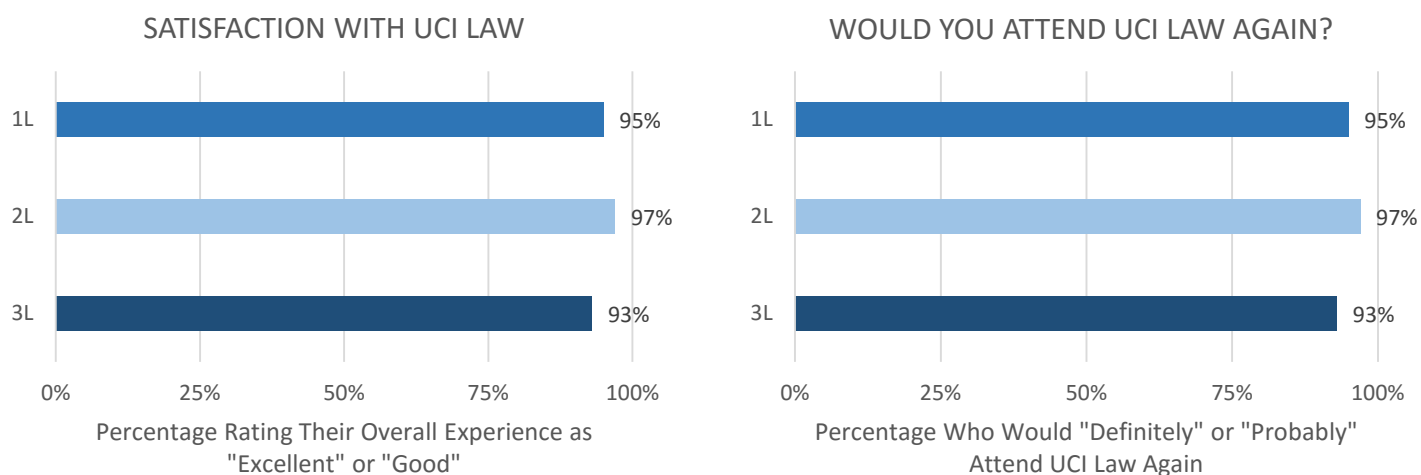


## 2016 Law School Survey of Student Engagement

UCI Law students in spring 2016 participated in the Law School Survey of Student Engagement (LSSSE) along with 17,820 students from 72 schools throughout the United States and Canada. The LSSSE asks students about their law school experience – how they spend their time, what they feel they've gained from their classes and their assessment of the quality of interactions with faculty and friends.

### HAPPY STUDENTS

UCI Law respondents far outpaced the national average in overall satisfaction and in survey participation\*.



\* The 2016 LSSSE average satisfaction rating across all schools is 85%, and 83% of all respondents say they would likely choose the same law school again. Additionally, 88% of our students participated in the survey, compared to an average of 51%.

### THE 1L EXPERIENCE

A large majority of the more than 100 first-year UCI Law students who participated in the 2016 LSSSE say they are satisfied with the Law School's student advising and counseling services. Here's a snapshot of their collective responses, alongside the average 1L ratings across all participating schools:

\*\* Percentage of students who responded "satisfied" or "very satisfied." UCI Law's 1Ls participated in the survey at an 86% rate. The average 1L response rate across all participating schools in 2016 was 53%.

### HOLISTIC EDUCATION

UCI Law respondents from all three classes said they acquire a broader legal education, develop clearer career goals, and contribute more to the welfare of their community than the national average.
