DIRECTIONS & PARKING

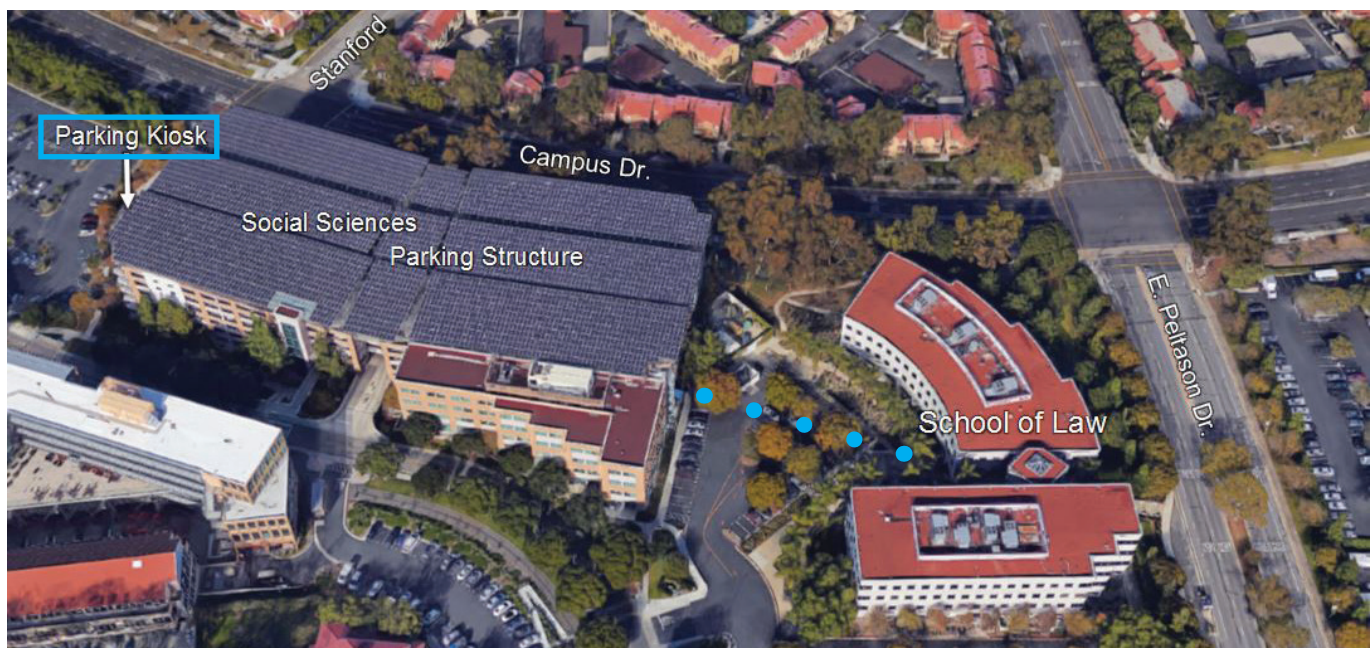
From the 405 Freeway Northbound:

- Left on Stanford Avenue into Social Sciences Parking Structure.

- Left on Campus Drive.
- Right on Stanford Avenue into Social Sciences Parking Structure.

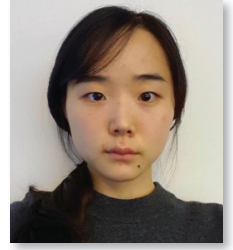

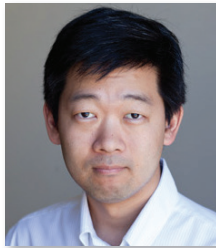
