Commencement 2013: California Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye

"I ask you especially to test the unspoken rules that permeate the legal profession. And by that, I mean the traditions of promotion and meritocracy and patrilineal positions. There was a time in my career when I was on my trajectory, and I wanted a family. And I knew from my peers and my



competitors in business and law that that was probably going to be considered off the beaten path. ... You have to choose what's right for you even though it may not look like what's right for everyone else and what's been traditionally right. (For me, I went into deep cover - Brownies, Girl Scouts, class mom, volleyball mom, baseball mom, basketball mom.) And forgo all legal fraternities and organizations and dinners and galas for several years. And then, try to make a comeback. ... It's possible, but you need the balance. And the balance ultimately comes down to a decision you make about yourself and what you need at the time."
